## **Wedding Checklist**

Start your wedding planning with an easy-to-use wedding checklist that will keep you organized and on top of things! I suggest you print out these wedding checklists and put them in your wedding notebook for easy reference.

### **6-12 Months Before:**

1. Announce your engagement
2. Pick a style for your wedding
3. Plan a budget
4. Meet with your officiant to set a date
5. Choose a location for your reception
6. Prepare your guest list
7. Decide on a color scheme for apparel, flowers and reception
8. Interview caterers and bakers
9. Visit with photographers and videographers
10. See florist and decide on flowers for ceremony
11. Draft and sign contracts

### **4 Months Before:**

1. Order invitations
2. Plan rehearsal dinner
3. If moving, look for new home or apartment
4. Sign up at bridal registries
5. Hire transportation for your wedding day
6. Plan honeymoon
7. Register with formalwear specialist and get fitted for tuxedo
8. Get measurement forms for all out of town groomsmen

### **1 Month Before**

1. Get your marriage license
2. Double check all contract details with wedding vendors
3. Adjust insurance policies, bank accounts, utilities, etc.
4. If needed, get change of address forms from post office

### **2 Weeks Before**

1. Make-sure all men have been measured for tuxedos
2. Catch up on thank you notes
3. Review reception seating plan
4. Wrap gifts for bride and groomsmen
5. Relax, take a deep breath

### **1 Week Before**

1. Pack for honeymoon
2. Get cash for gratuities and issue checks to vendors
3. Enjoy bachelor party and rehearsal dinner
4. Pick up tuxedo and have final fitting
5. Give caterer final head count
6. Present bride with her special gift
7. Get haircut and manicure
8. Give groomsmen gifts at rehearsal dinner or reception

### **The Big Day**

1. Double check details
2. Wedding bands
3. Ring pillow
4. Garter, etc
5. Get to the ceremony in plenty of time
6. Relax and enjoy your wedding
